

**Secretariat Meeting**

From 9<sup>th</sup> February to 2<sup>nd</sup> March, the Secretariat held its first ordinary meeting of this year. ## ☑ Training

### Coming to Life! Training Sessions (1)



During the 7<sup>th</sup> International Council of the ICYCW there were two days of work dedicated to training. In these days certain useful tools for training were presented to help create a link between the reality which young workers experience daily and the educative plan proposed by the YCW. The topics dealt with were chosen according to the needs of national Movements and were tackled in a manner based on the experience of action at national level.

Through this section in *ICYCW-CIJOC On Line*, we want to keep alive the memory of the themes which we worked on and to prompt national leaders to organise national and diocesan meetings to follow up and deepen this work.

In this first number of 2009 we present the workshop on **Training for YCW trainers in Life Situations**.

The aim was to get to know the fundamental principles of the YCW so as to then propose the same kind of training to young leaders at the local level.

- **The YCW Training Manual** produced by the ICYCW: how to get to know it, put it to use and keep using it; how to prepare a training session.
- **The Action Campaign**: its formative value and how to carry it out in our particular situation.
- **Finance**: the management of the finances in a Movement such as the YCW.

#### **Training Manual – How to use this booklet**

This manual is intended for the use of those responsible for the development of the YCW Movement at Regional/Diocesan level to understand the principles and methods of the YCW in a more extensive and deeper way. The book is intended as a help to **training others**. We have tried to keep it as simple as possible so that the material can be used to present the key elements of the YCW.

It is written from an overall international perspective and will require adaptation to local practice and culture whilst keeping to the essential principles and method.

After the presentation of the Manual we experienced together the planning of a training session for a Diocesan team on one of the sections of the Manual adapting the suggestions according to the needs of the local Movement.

#### **Action Campaign**

In this part of the workshop we saw how to organise an Action Campaign and how this could be an educative process for young people.

An action campaign is a process of: awareness and study, reflection and prayer, decision and action on a chosen topic which is important to young people. It is carried out on a regional or national basis. It involves many YCW groups with their friends and contact joined together in a united effort.

The YCW action campaign follows the **SEE JUDGE ACT** method. Before starting the SEE JUDGE ACT stages, is necessary a preparation phase concluded with the launch and after is good to have a finale and a review with the coordination team.

The purposes of an Action Campaign are: take action, train leaders, promote togetherness, publicise the YCW, make contacts and build friendships.

#### **Finance**

In this part of the workshop we looked more deeply into the role of the Treasurer in a Movement like the YCW which tries to be self financing. From the Training Manual we discovered the importance of the role of the leader not just in a technical sense but above all in training others to appreciate the value of the economic autonomy of the Movement and of the young person.

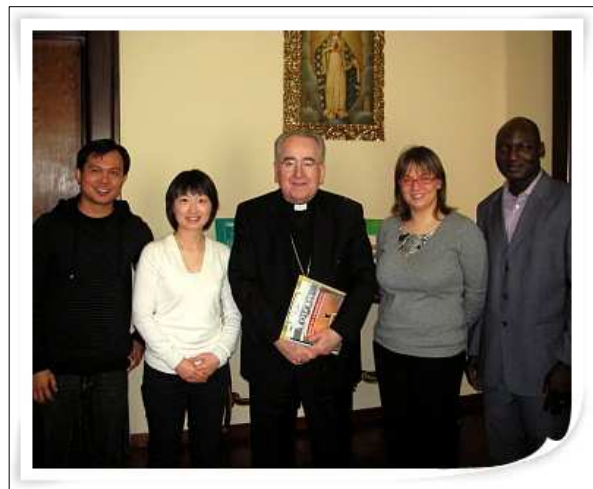

## Meeting with Cardinal Rylko

The members of the Secretariat had a meeting this year with The Pontifical Council of the Laity (PCL).

In this meeting with Cardinal Rylko, President of the PCL, we introduced the Secretariat members and presented our activities. We also took the opportunity to give him the Report, Resolutions, and Future Plans (General and Continental) of the 7<sup>th</sup> International Council.



We spoke to him about the situation of the National Movements, the reality of young people and especially we talked with him about the difficulties facing young people in working life such as unemployment and insecure jobs. We presented some Action Campaigns of the Movements on these issues.

About this, Cardinal Rylko said that the YCW's work and mission are important to the present situation of the world, and he encouraged the YCW Movements. He reminded us that the YCW has a Christian identity and that the PCL always support the ICYCW.

We received a lot of support and encouragement from this meeting and it was a good time to reflect more on our challenges as young Christian working people.
